Britt will be sending Ray a schedule of when that we can use the building. Ray also discussed traffic control. We had originally asked if on certain days or times if a cop could help kids cross the street. Unfortunately, Britt said they wouldn't be able to have a cop on stand by for that reason. Ray will be asking if we can put up additional crossing signs. We also would like to create a safe routes map for the kids, we will then add these routes on to marketing materials. The city of Virginia will be mapping trails and walking routes however, it will most likely not be completed by this summer. They do plan on having a temporary walking map completed. Anna is also working with AEOA/Arrowhead Transit about the "kids ride free" program. Making sure that is still going to be running this summer. If it is, we will also include this on our marketing materials. Chad spoke with the Virginia Community Lakes Committee and they will be adding additional bathrooms to the beach area. The city of Virginia also recommended that on the 2nd and 3rd of July maybe the kids could help the city decorate for the 4th.

We will also need to come up with a name for the event. Sara will speak with Elizabeth Kelly from United Way to see if we will be sticking with the "Meet Up and Chow Down" name. Sara suggested "Meet up and Chow Down Recharged." When a name is figured out we will ask the United Way to put this program on their website. We will also see if we can add marketing materials into the backpacks for buddy backpacks.
